I am writing to formally submit my opposition to BZA Docket 13/26 concerning the proposed digital billboard at 10563 N. Interstate 10 Service Road.

Based on publicly available information, this location is within zoning and overlay districts that prohibit billboards, including the Eastern New Orleans Renaissance Corridor Use Restriction Overlay and the Corridor Transformation Design Overlay. In addition, the site is within 500 feet of residential zoning, which further prohibits billboards under the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance.

I am also deeply concerned about the process used for this application. The required notice was not properly provided to the Eastern New Orleans Neighborhood Advisory Commission (ENONAC). This denied residents and community organizations the opportunity to participate meaningfully in a decision that directly affects our neighborhoods.

For these reasons, I respectfully request that the Board:

- ✓ Restart the process in full compliance with all notice requirements before taking any further action;  
and
- ✓ Deny BZA Docket 13/26 with prejudice;

Our communities deserve transparency, fairness, and full compliance with the law when zoning decisions are made.
